This week we focused our learning on aeroplanes. We listened to the story 'Maisy goes by plane' and discussed past experiences of travelling by plane. Furthermore, we explored the different parts of the plane and discussed the different transport options i.e. train, cars, boats and plane.

During continuous provision, the children enjoyed participating in a range of activities, which included drawing/ painting their versions of planes, transport junk modelling, mark making using sticks, painting with different materials such as cotton and sponges, investigating numbers in the water play. Sensory activities included searching for Lego in rice and arranging numbers in the correct sequence.


Red Acorns
